- as its symbol a demonstration of the sacrifice of himself in his death;
- as its benefit, the confirmation of faith and spiritual nourishment in individual believers;
- as its exhortation, the reminder to grow and engage in all duties owed to our Lord;
- as its effect, a bond and pledge of our union with him and each other.

If you are not a baptized believer in good standing with your local church, we ask that you refrain from this meal and use this time instead take this moment to reflect upon your life and seek the grace God freely offers to all who cast themselves upon Jesus.

For our brothers and sisters in Christ with gluten-sensitivities, our host will have dedicated elements available. They will look for your raised hand.

## Public Reading of Scripture

John 2:1–12 (ESV)

### The Wedding at Cana

2 On the third day there was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. 2 Jesus also was invited to the wedding with his disciples. 3 When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus said to him, “They have no wine.” 4 And Jesus said to her, “Woman, what does this have to do with me? My hour has not yet come.” 5 His mother said to the servants, “Do whatever he tells you.”

6 Now there were six stone water jars there for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. 7 Jesus said to the servants, “Fill the jars with water.” And they filled them up to the brim. 8 And he said to them, “Now draw some out and take it to the master of the feast.” So they took it. 9 When the master of the feast tasted the water now become wine, and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called the bridegroom 10 and said to him, “Everyone serves the good wine first, and



when people have drunk freely, then the poor wine. But you have kept the good wine until now.”<sup>11</sup> This, the first of his signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested his glory. And his disciples believed in him.

<sup>12</sup> After this he went down to Capernaum, with his mother and his brothers and his disciples, and they stayed there for a few days.

## Affirmation of the Faith

*Orthodox Catechism* (1680) Lesson 11 & 12

Q&A 29

Q: Why is the Son of God called "Jesus," which means "savior"?

**A: Because he saves us from our sins.<sup>1</sup> Salvation cannot be found in anyone else; it is futile to look for any salvation elsewhere.<sup>2</sup>**

Q&A 30

Q: Do those who look for their salvation and security in saints, in themselves, or elsewhere really believe in the only savior Jesus?

**A: No. Although they boast of being his, by their deeds they deny the only savior and deliverer, Jesus.<sup>3</sup> Either Jesus is not a perfect savior, or those who in true faith accept this savior have in him all they need for their salvation.<sup>4</sup>**
