Scripture Reading

John 6:1-21 (ESV)

Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand

6 After this Jesus went away to the other side of the Sea of Galilee, which is the Sea of Tiberias. ² And a large crowd was following him, because they saw the signs that he was doing on the sick. ³ Jesus went up on the mountain, and there he sat down with his disciples. ⁴ Now the Passover, the feast of the Jews, was at hand. ⁵ Lifting up his eyes, then, and seeing that a large crowd was coming toward him, Jesus said to Philip, “Where are we to buy bread, so that these people may eat?” ⁶ He said this to test him, for he himself knew what he would do. ⁷ Philip answered him, “Two hundred denarii worth of bread would not be enough for each of them to get a little.” ⁸ One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, said to him, ⁹ “There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish, but what are they for so many?” ¹⁰ Jesus said, “Have the people sit down.” Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, about five thousand in number. ¹¹ Jesus then took the loaves, and when he had given thanks, he distributed them to those who were seated. So also the fish, as much as they wanted. ¹² And when they had eaten their fill, he told his disciples, “Gather up the leftover fragments, that nothing may be lost.” ¹³ So they gathered them up and filled twelve baskets with fragments from the five barley loaves left by those who



had eaten. ¹⁴When the people saw the sign that he had done, they said, “This is indeed the Prophet who is to come into the world!”

¹⁵Perceiving then that they were about to come and take him by force to make him king, Jesus withdrew again to the mountain by himself.

Jesus Walks on Water

¹⁶When evening came, his disciples went down to the sea, ¹⁷got into a boat, and started across the sea to Capernaum. It was now dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them. ¹⁸The sea became rough because a strong wind was blowing. ¹⁹When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were frightened. ²⁰But he said to them, “It is I; do not be afraid.” ²¹Then they were glad to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land to which they were going.

Affirmation of the Faith

Orthodox Catechism (1680) Lesson 23

Q 59: What good does it do you, however, to believe all this?

A: In Christ I am right with God and heir to life everlasting.¹

Q 60: How are you right with God?

A: Only by true faith in Jesus Christ.² Even though my conscience accuses me of having grievously sinned against all God's commandments and of never having kept any of them,³ and even though I am still inclined toward all evil,⁴ nevertheless, without my deserving it at all,⁵ out of sheer grace,⁶ God grants and credits to me the perfect satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness of Christ,⁷ as if I had never sinned nor been a sinner, as if I had been as perfectly obedient as

Christ was obedient for me.⁸ All I need to do is to accept this gift of God with a believing heart.⁹

Q 61: Why do you say that by faith alone you are right with God?

A: It is not because of any value my faith has that God is pleased with me. Only Christ's satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness make me right with God.¹⁰ And I can receive this righteousness and make it mine in no other way than by faith alone.¹¹
