

The Coming King of Zion

9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey,

Affirmation of the Faith

Orthodox Catechism (1680); Various thematic selections

Q29: Why is the Son of God called "Jesus," meaning "savior"?

A: Because he saves us from our sins. Salvation cannot be found in anyone else; it is futile to look for any salvation elsewhere.²

Q 31: Why is he called "Christ," meaning "anointed"?

A: Because he has been ordained by God the Father and has been anointed with the Holy Spirit to be our chief prophet and teacher who perfectly reveals to us the secret counsel and will of God for our deliverance;³

our only high priest who has set us free by the one sacrifice of his body, and who continually pleads our cause with the Father;⁴

and our eternal king who governs us by his Word and Spirit, and who guards us and keeps us in the freedom he has won for us.⁵

Q: What do we mean when we ask for Jesus's kingdom to come?

A: "Your kingdom come" means, Rule us by your Word and Spirit in such a way that more and more we submit to you. Keep your church strong, and add to it. Destroy the devil's work; destroy every force which revolts against you and every conspiracy against your Word. Do this until your kingdom is so complete and perfect that in it you are all in all.⁶

Confession and Promise of Grace Ephesians 5:8–14 (ESV)

⁸ For at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light ⁹ (for the fruit of light is found in all that is good and right and true), ¹⁰ and try to discern what is pleasing to the Lord. ¹¹ Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them. ¹² For it is shameful even to speak of the things that they do in secret. ¹³ But when anything is exposed by the light, it becomes visible, ¹⁴ for anything that becomes visible is light. Therefore it says,

"Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you."
