John 7:37-52 (ESV)

Rivers of Living Water

³⁷ On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. ³⁸ Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.' " ³⁹ Now this he said about the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were to receive, for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

Division Among the People

⁴⁰ When they heard these words, some of the people said, "This really is the Prophet." ⁴¹ Others said, "This is the Christ." But some said, "Is the Christ to come from Galilee? ⁴² Has not the Scripture said that the Christ comes from the offspring of David, and comes from Bethlehem, the village where David was?" ⁴³ So there was a division among the people over him. ⁴⁴ Some of them wanted to arrest him, but no one laid hands on him.

⁴⁵ The officers then came to the chief priests and Pharisees, who said to them, "Why did you not bring him?" ⁴⁶ The officers answered, "No one ever spoke like this man!" ⁴⁷ The Pharisees answered them, "Have you also been deceived? ⁴⁸ Have any of the authorities or the Pharisees believed in him? ⁴⁹ But this crowd that does not know the law is accursed." ⁵⁰ Nicodemus, who had gone to him before, and who was one of them, said to them, ⁵¹ "Does our law judge a man without first giving him a hearing and learning what he does?" ⁵² They replied, "Are you from Galilee too? Search and see that no prophet arises from Galilee."

Affirmation of the Faith

Orthodox Catechism (1680) Lesson 23

Q 86: Who should come to the Lord's table?

A: All baptized believers in Christ who are displeased with themselves because of their continued sins, but who nevertheless trust that their sins are pardoned and that their continuing weakness is covered by the death of Christ, and who also desire more and more to strengthen their faith and to lead a better life.

Hypocrites and those who are unrepentant, however, eat and drink judgment on themselves.¹

Q 87: Are those to be admitted to the Lord's Supper who show by what they say and do that they are unbelieving and ungodly?

A: No, that would dishonor God's covenant and bring down God's anger upon the entire congregation.

Therefore, according to the instruction of Christ and his apostles, the Christian church is duty-bound to exclude such people until they repent.²

Q 88: How should this ordinance of the Lord's Supper be closed?

A: In singing praises to God. In Scripture, we find our Lord and his disciples sang after the Supper; and if Christ, who was going to die, sang, then we have even more reasons to sing because we will not die but live eternally with the Father, Son, and Spirit in inexpressible glory.³
