Exodus: Redeemer and Redeemed / Ex 19:1–25

Sermon Discussion Questions

How does the encounter between God and the Israelites at Mount Sinai (Exodus 19) challenge your understanding of God's holiness and transcendence? How can recognizing this aspect of God deepen your worship and daily life?

The sermon emphasizes the purpose of the covenant between God and Israel. How do you see the covenant's promises—being a treasured possession, a kingdom of priests, and a holy nation—fulfilled in your life through Jesus Christ?

Just as the Israelites had to prepare to meet God at Mount Sinai, how can you prepare yourself spiritually to encounter God in your daily life and during worship? What specific practices or changes will you commit to this week?

Moses acted as a mediator between God and the Israelites, highlighting the need for mediation in our relationship with God. How can you support others in your faith community to draw closer to God? Share a specific way you will encourage or help someone in the group this week.

The sermon underscores our identity as God's treasured possession and a holy nation through Christ. How does this identity shape your interactions with others and your involvement in the church and community? What is one way you can live out this identity more fully?
