## Scripture Reading

John 13:36–14:14

### Jesus Foretells Peter's Denial

<sup>36</sup> Simon Peter said to him, “Lord, where are you going?” Jesus answered him, “Where I am going you cannot follow me now, but you will follow afterward.”  
<sup>37</sup> Peter said to him, “Lord, why can I not follow you now? I will lay down my life for you.” <sup>38</sup> Jesus answered, “Will you lay down your life for me? Truly, truly, I say to you, the rooster will not crow till you have denied me three times.

### I Am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life

**14** “Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. <sup>2</sup> In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? <sup>3</sup> And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. <sup>4</sup> And you know the way to where I am going.” <sup>5</sup> Thomas said to him, “Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?” <sup>6</sup> Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. <sup>7</sup> If you had known me, you would have known my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him.”

<sup>8</sup> Philip said to him, “Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us.” <sup>9</sup> Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, ‘Show us the Father?’ <sup>10</sup> Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but the Father who dwells in me does his works. <sup>11</sup> Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else believe on account of the works themselves.

<sup>12</sup> “Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the



Father.<sup>13</sup> Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.<sup>14</sup> If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.

## Affirmation of the Faith

*Orthodox Catechism (1680)*

Q 75<sup>1</sup>: How does baptism remind you and assure you that Christ's one sacrifice on the cross is for you personally?

**A: In this way: Christ instituted this outward washing<sup>2</sup> and with it gave the promise that, as surely as water washes away the dirt from the body, so certainly his blood and his Spirit wash away my soul's impurity, in other words, all my sins.<sup>3</sup>**

Q 76: What does it mean to be washed with Christ's blood and baptized by the Spirit?

**A: To be washed with Christ's blood means that God, by grace, has forgiven my sins because of Christ's blood poured out for me in his sacrifice on the cross.<sup>4</sup>**

**To be baptized with Christ's Spirit means that the Holy Spirit has renewed me and set me apart to be a member of Christ so that more and more I become dead to sin and increasingly live a holy and blameless life.<sup>5</sup>**

Question 77: Where does Christ promise that we are washed with his blood and Spirit as surely as we are washed with the water of baptism?

**A: In the institution of baptism where he says: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."<sup>6</sup>**

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<sup>1</sup> Interested readers will note a jump over Q73 and Q74. These are extended paragraphs on why Scripture demonstrates infants should not be baptized. While too long for corporate worship, consider studying them at home. **Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.<sup>7</sup> This promise is repeated when Scripture calls baptism the washing of rebirth<sup>8</sup> and the washing away of sins.<sup>9</sup>**
