Affirmation of the Faith

Orthodox Catechism (1680 modernized)

Q 92: If we're saved by God's grace through Christ and not because of anything we've done, then why do we still need to do good things?"

A: It's true that Christ has saved us by shedding his blood.

But we do good because Christ, by his Spirit, is also changing us to be more like him – so that in everything we do, we show how thankful we are to God for all he's done for us,¹ and so that God is praised through us.²

We also do good so that we can be confident in our faith by seeing its results,³ and so that, through our godly lives, others might be drawn to Christ.⁴

Q 93: Can people be saved if they don't turn away from their sin and turn to God?

A: Never. The Bible clearly says that no one who is sexually immoral, worships idols, commits adultery, steals, is greedy, gets drunk, gossips, or robs others will inherit God's kingdom.⁵
