## Scripture Reading

Hebrews 3:1–19

### Jesus Greater Than Moses

<sup>3</sup> Therefore, holy brothers, you who share in a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the apostle and high priest of our confession, <sup>2</sup> who was faithful to him who appointed him, just as Moses also was faithful in all God's house. <sup>3</sup> For Jesus has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses—as much more glory as the builder of a house has more honor than the house itself. <sup>4</sup> (For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God.) <sup>5</sup> Now Moses was faithful in all God's house as a servant, to testify to the things that were to be spoken later, <sup>6</sup> but Christ is faithful over God's house as a son. And we are his house, if indeed we hold fast our confidence and our boasting in our hope.

### A Rest for the People of God

<sup>7</sup> Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says,

- “Today, if you hear his voice,  
<sup>8</sup> do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion,  
on the day of testing in the wilderness,  
<sup>9</sup> where your fathers put me to the test  
and saw my works for forty years.  
<sup>10</sup> Therefore I was provoked with that generation,  
and said, ‘They always go astray in their heart;  
they have not known my ways.’  
<sup>11</sup> As I swore in my wrath,  
‘They shall not enter my rest.’”



<sup>12</sup>Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. <sup>13</sup>But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called “today,” that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. <sup>14</sup>For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end. <sup>15</sup>As it is said,

“Today, if you hear his voice,  
do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.”

<sup>16</sup>For who were those who heard and yet rebelled? Was it not all those who left Egypt led by Moses? <sup>17</sup>And with whom was he provoked for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness? <sup>18</sup>And to whom did he swear that they would not enter his rest, but to those who were disobedient? <sup>19</sup>So we see that they were unable to enter because of unbelief.

## Affirmation of the Faith

*Orthodox Catechism (1680 modernized)*

Q129. What is the ninth commandment?

**A. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.<sup>1</sup>**

Q130. What is God’s will for you in the ninth commandment?

**A. God’s will is that I never give false testimony against anyone, twist another person’s words, gossip, slander, or join in condemning someone without a fair hearing or just cause.<sup>2</sup>**

**Instead, whether in court or in daily life, I should avoid lying and every form of deceit, since these are the devil’s tools and bring down God’s righteous anger.<sup>3</sup>**

**I should love the truth, speak it honestly, and confess it openly.<sup>4</sup> And I should do all I can to protect and promote my neighbor’s good name.<sup>5</sup>**
