Parents





Scripture Reading

Hebrews 3:1-19

Jesus Greater Than Moses

3 Therefore, holy brothers, you who share in a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the apostle and high priest of our confession, ²who was faithful to him who appointed him, just as Moses also was faithful in all God's house. ³ For Jesus has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses—as much more glory as the builder of a house has more honor than the house itself. ⁴ (For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God.) ⁵ Now Moses was faithful in all God's house as a servant, to testify to the things that were to be spoken later, ⁶ but Christ is faithful over God's house as a son. And we are his house, if indeed we hold fast our confidence and our boasting in our hope.

A Rest for the People of God

⁷Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says,

"Today, if you hear his voice,

- do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, on the day of testing in the wilderness,
- 9 where your fathers put me to the test and saw my works for forty years.
- Therefore I was provoked with that generation, and said, 'They always go astray in their heart; they have not known my ways.'
- ¹¹ As I swore in my wrath, 'They shall not enter my rest.'"

¹² Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. ¹³ But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. ¹⁴ For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end. ¹⁵ As it is said,

"Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."

¹⁶ For who were those who heard and yet rebelled? Was it not all those who left Egypt led by Moses? ¹⁷ And with whom was he provoked for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness? ¹⁸ And to whom did he swear that they would not enter his rest, but to those who were disobedient? ¹⁹ So we see that they were unable to enter because of unbelief.

Affirmation of the Faith

Orthodox Catechism (1680 modernized)

Q129. What is the ninth commandment?

A. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.1

Q130. What is God's will for you in the ninth commandment?

A. God's will is that I never give false testimony against anyone, twist another person's words, gossip, slander, or join in condemning someone without a fair hearing or just cause.²

Instead, whether in court or in daily life, I should avoid lying and every form of deceit, since these are the devil's tools and bring down God's righteous anger.³

I should love the truth, speak it honestly, and confess it openly. 4 And I should do all I can to protect and promote my neighbor's good name. 5

Confession and Assurance of Pardon

1 John 2:1-2

2 My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. ² He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.
