## Sermon

“The Spirit’s Help and Our Confidence”

Romans 8:26-27

Zach Carter

1. Suffering rattles the human condition.
2. We rarely know how to pray to survive suffering.
3. The Spirit’s work in suffering is intercession, not revelation.
  - a. This happens between the persons of God—so we can trust God’s purpose.
  - b. This happens ordinarily and not often extraordinarily.
4. We have assurance in suffering because God had already accounted for our weakness.

### Scripture Reading

1 Samuel 1:21–2:11

#### Samuel Given to the LORD

<sup>21</sup> The man Elkanah and all his house went up to offer to the LORD the yearly sacrifice and to pay his vow. <sup>22</sup> But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her husband, “As soon as the child is weaned, I will bring him, so that he may appear in the presence of the LORD and dwell there forever.” <sup>23</sup> Elkanah her husband said to her, “Do what seems best to you; wait until you have weaned him; only, may the LORD establish his word.” So the woman remained and nursed her son until she weaned him. <sup>24</sup> And when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, along with a three-year-old bull, an ephah of flour, and a skin of wine, and she brought him to the house of the LORD at Shiloh. And the child was young. <sup>25</sup> Then they slaughtered the bull, and they brought the child to Eli. <sup>26</sup> And she said, “Oh, my lord! As you live, my lord, I am the woman who was standing here in your presence, praying to the LORD. <sup>27</sup> For this child I prayed, and the LORD has granted me my petition that I made to him. <sup>28</sup> Therefore I have lent him to the LORD. As long as he lives, he is lent to the LORD.”

And he worshiped the LORD there.

#### Hannah's Prayer

**2** And Hannah prayed and said,

“My heart exults in the LORD;  
my horn is exalted in the LORD.  
My mouth derides my enemies,  
because I rejoice in your salvation.

- <sup>3</sup> Talk no more so very proudly,

he lifts the needy from the ash heap  
to make them sit with princes  
and inherit a seat of honor.  
For the pillars of the earth are the LORD's,  
and on them he has set the world.
- <sup>9</sup> "He will guard the feet of his faithful ones,  
but the wicked shall be cut off in darkness,  
for not by might shall a man prevail.
- <sup>10</sup> The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces;  
against them he will thunder in heaven.  
The LORD will judge the ends of the earth;  
he will give strength to his king  
and exalt the horn of his anointed."

<sup>11</sup> Then Elkanah went home to Ramah. And the boy was ministering to the LORD in the presence of Eli the priest.

### Affirmation of the Faith

*Orthodox Catechism*

Q 29: Why is the Son of God called "Jesus," meaning "savior"?



**A: Because he saves us from our sins.<sup>1</sup> Salvation cannot be found in anyone else; it is futile to look for any salvation elsewhere.<sup>2</sup>**

Q30: Do those who look for their salvation and security in saints, in themselves, or elsewhere really believe in the only savior Jesus?

**A: No. Although they claim to be his, by their deeds, they deny the only savior and deliverer, Jesus.<sup>3</sup>**

**Either Jesus is not a complete Savior, or everyone who trusts in him already has all that is needed for salvation.<sup>4</sup>**
